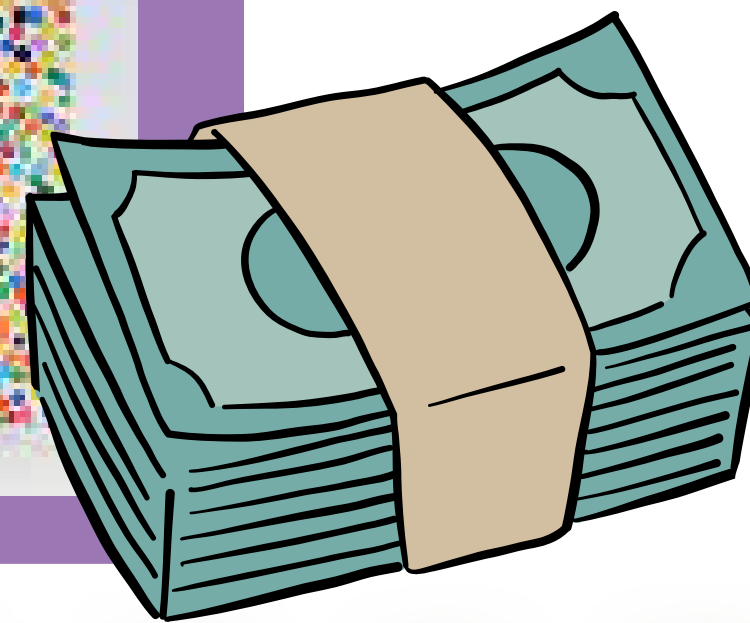




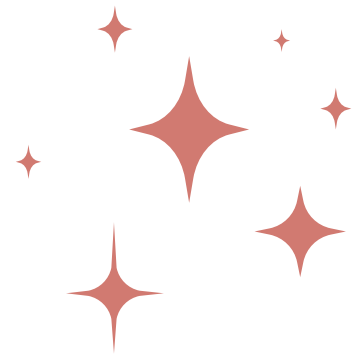
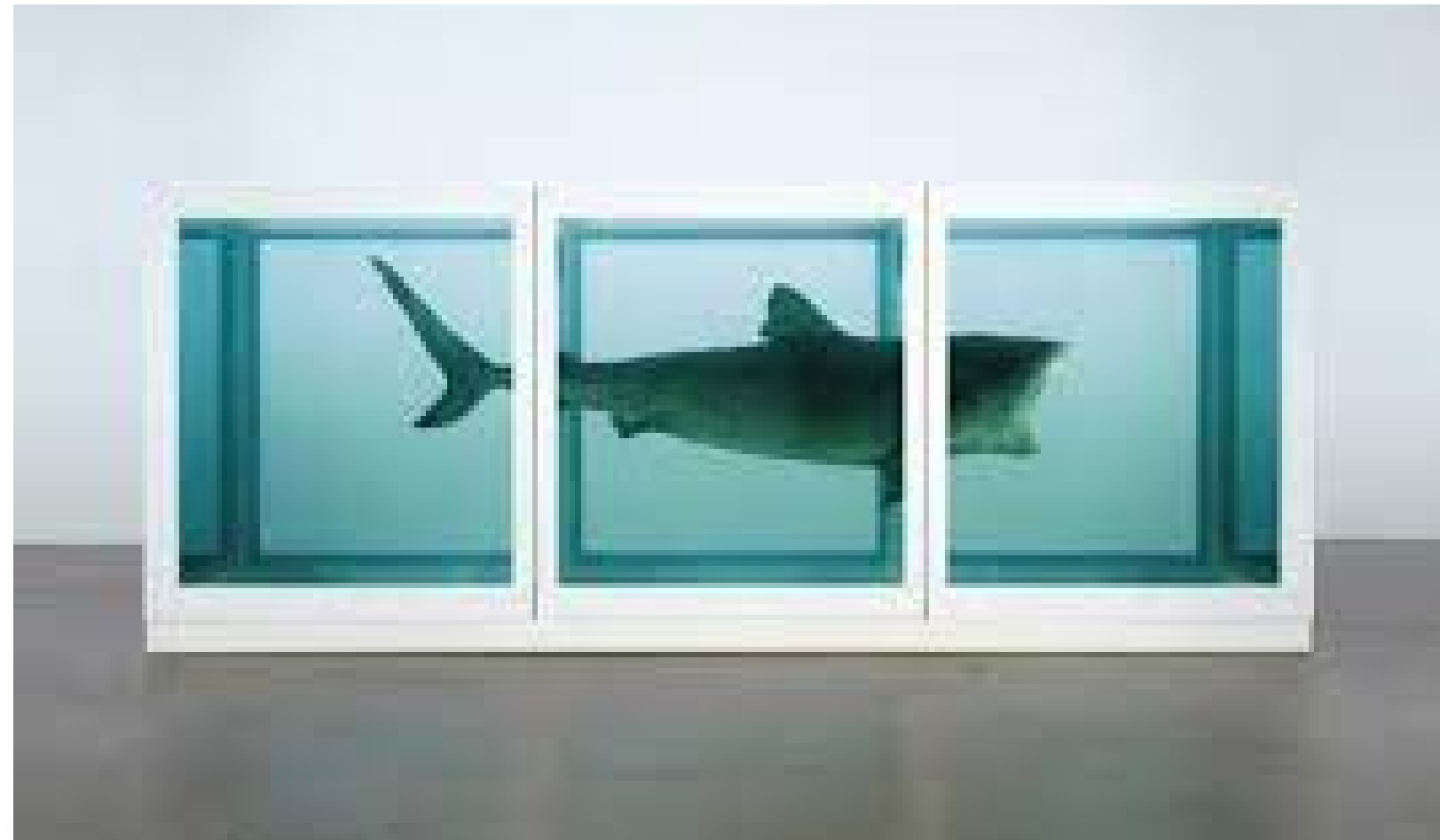
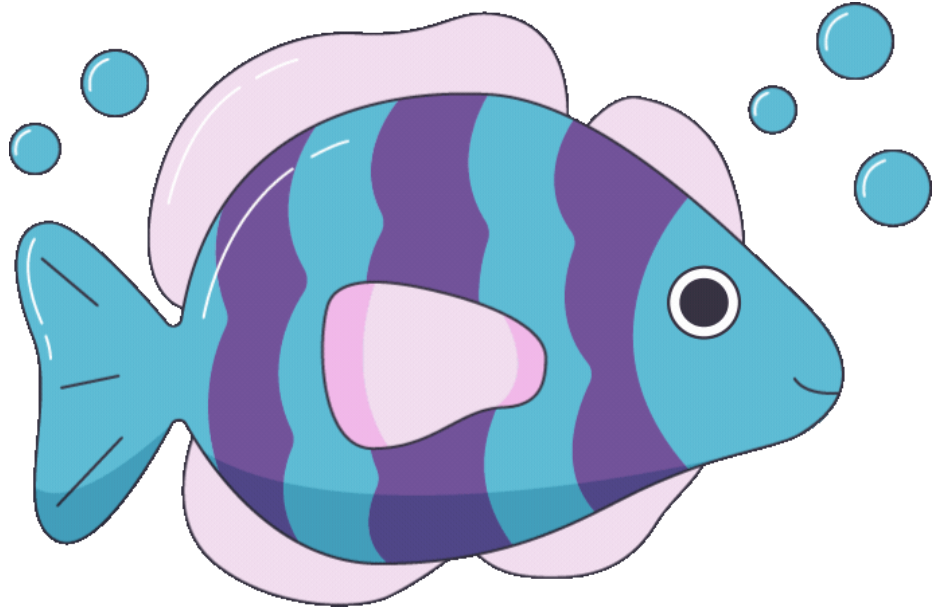
DAMIEN HIRST

coloured cards

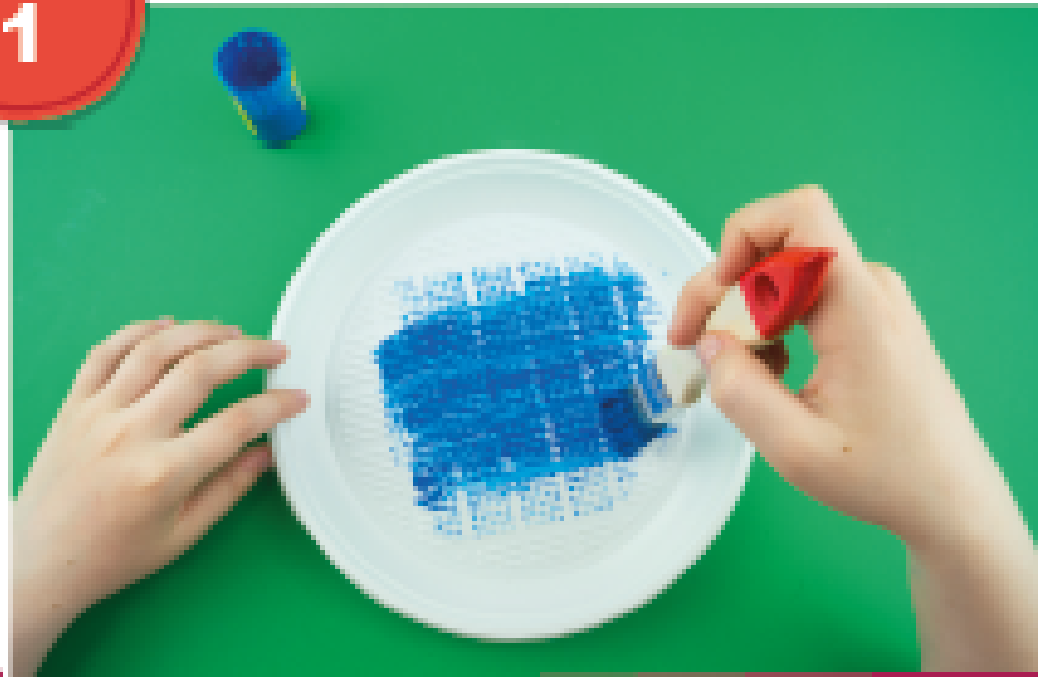
scissors and glue

felt tips

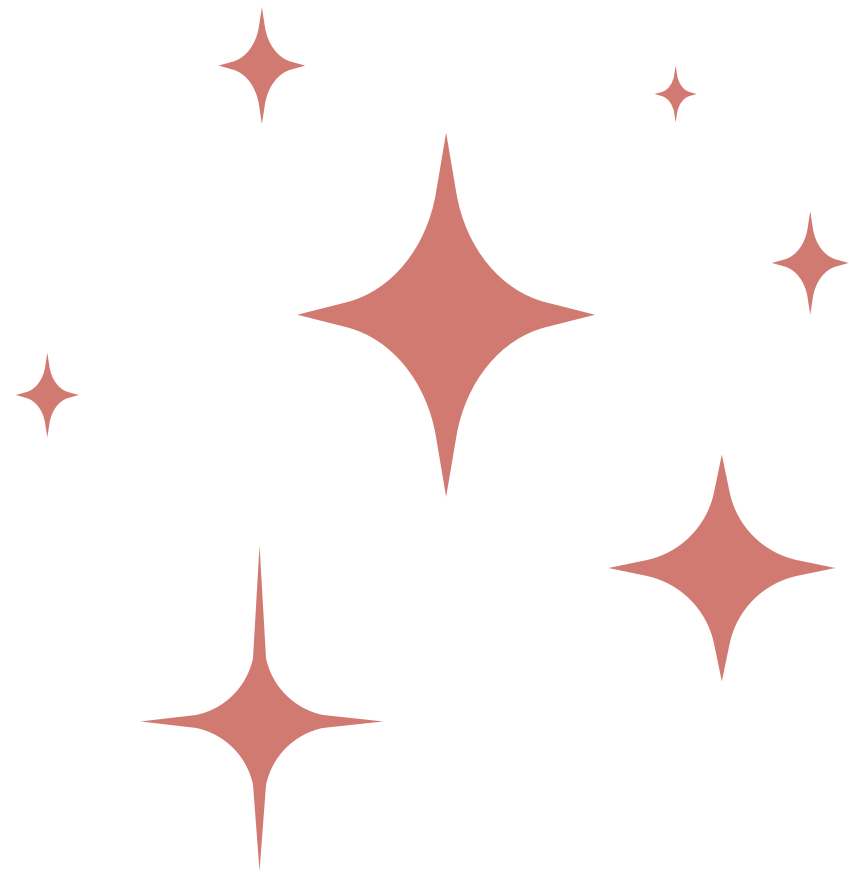
blue paint and paintbrushes

2

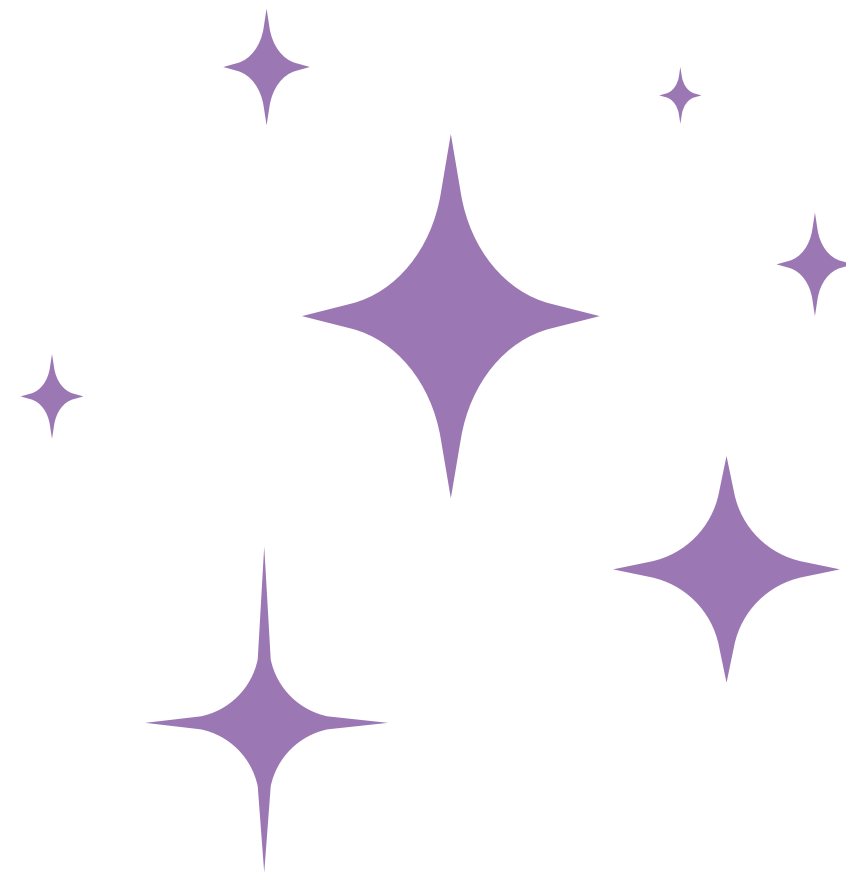


Draw and cut out fish and seaweed.

Glue the fish and seaweed onto the blue plate. Decorate the aquarium with pebbles and glitter or sequins.

Cut out the bottom of the second paper plate.

Glue the plastic sheet to the outside of the second paper plate.

Glue second paper plate to the first paper plate to make the aquarium.
